DEQ holds hearing on proposed clean water projects

On April 15 the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) held a public hearing on projects propose by local governments for ARRA funding. Most of these projects would upgrade and improve wastewater treatment plants. Several others would promote water reuse.

Last week DEQ released a priority list of 33 clean water projects totaling \$114 million against which \$76.9 in federal stimulus funds are available. That list (and other information about ARRA funds for clean water projects) is available [on this link](#).

At its next meeting the State Water Control Board (SWCB) is scheduled to consider allocations for the “clean water” projects proposed for funding under ARRA. That meeting is scheduled to begin at 9:30 a.m. on Monday, April 27, in House Room C of the General Assembly Building in Richmond. If necessary, the Board will also meet in the same location on the following day.
