List of Virginia localities receiving energy efficiency block grants from the U.S. Department of Energy

Vice President Joe Biden and Energy Secretary Steven Chu announced plans to invest \$3.2 billion in energy efficiency and conservation projects in U.S. cities, counties, states, territories and Native American tribes through the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant program for projects that reduce total energy use and fossil fuel emissions, and improve energy efficiency nationwide.
