ARRA grant tracking update

- Gov. Timothy's M. Kaine's office shared the attached file with VACo. It is the state's updated catalogue of [eligible ARRA grants](#). VACo will provide the members with an updated version when it is made available.

The document provides both summary information about available grants and links to the specific grant announcements – via the responsible federal agency.

Localities must be registered through [Grants.gov](#) in order apply for federal grants. The web site walks you through the registration process.

- The week of March 30, the Kaine Administration began posting an updated list of competitive grants on [Stimulus.virginia.gov](#). It also intends to update the list at least once a week. The post is the same document that VACo is sending to you!
- As announced by VACo on March 25: The Kaine Administration is asking VACo and VML to help track grant requests. Specifically, the governor's ARRA leadership team is asking local governments to document grants that counties, cities and towns are seeking from the federal government (i.e. not the projects you previously submitted to the governor's Web site). Your grant requests will be posted on the state's Web site: [stimulus.virginia.gov](#).

To that end, please complete the [attached form](#), which includes a line for each grant request. Please return completed forms to [Mike Edwards](#) who will forward the information to the appropriate state contacts. The governor is requiring state agencies to report all of their grant requests.
