Public Safety: VDCJS posts guidelines for new Byrne eligible grants; Applications due to DCJS by Feb. 12, 2010

[The Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services](#) has posted guidelines on its Web site for those interested in submitting grant applications for funding new projects through [the Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Program](#) (JAG).

Two-Phase Solicitation Process

This grant solicitation is a two-phase process. In the Request for Project Proposals phase, eligible applicants interested in applying for JAG funding must first submit a Project Proposal in accordance with the instructions contained in DCJS' 2010 JAG guidelines.

Project Proposals are due to DCJS by 3 p.m., Monday, Nov. 23, and must be submitted electronically.

In the Invited Applicants phase, those whose Project Proposals are approved will be invited to send full grant applications to DCJS based on their approved proposals. Applications from Invited Applicants must be received by DCJS by 4 p.m., Friday, Feb. 12, 2010.
