Performs varied and complex engineering duties in connection with the planning, design, improvement, and inspection of engineering and construction projects in the City with particular emphasis on transportation and infrastructure. Work also involves providing technical support in responding to citizen concerns pertaining to drainage, erosion, traffic, utility systems, or other departmental issues. Supervises Engineering Division and GIS. Ability to read, analyze and interpret professional documents, computerized maps, journals, technical procedures or governmental regulations, as applied to planning, location, design, construction, and maintenance of the area or projects of assignment.

Bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering or related field supplemented by previous related experience. A Professional Engineer license or an Engineer in Training certification is required with the ability to obtain a Professional Engineer license in a reasonable amount of time. Must have a valid driver's license.
