FY18 Revenue Sharing Program Recommendation

- Total Requests: \$212.6M
- Budget for FY17 Revenue Sharing: \$100M
- Funds Previously De-allocated by CTB: \$1.7M
- Funds released by localities since de-allocation: \$1.8M
- Total Available for FY17 Requests: \$103.5M
 - All requests meeting first priority criteria fully funded
 - Insufficient funding available for second or third priority or other requests
 - Priority 1 requests recommended for funding \$102.1M

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Revenue Sharing Program Study Committee

- Revenue Sharing Program Study Committee
 Public Meetings:
 - March 14 15
 - April 17
 - May 15
- Committee provided with survey feedback Local Assistance Division received from localities and districts to assist in their reviews
- Committee reviewed historical data to assist in their analysis of the Program



Revenue Sharing Program Study Committee Allocation Recommendations

- Reduce the maximum a locality can apply for each fiscal year from \$10M to \$5M (\$10M max per biennium)
- Establish a lifetime allocation maximum of \$10M (state match) per project

Revenue Sharing Study Committee Transfer Recommendations

• Transfers

- Most transfers will now follow deallocation process (funds to projects with Ad/Award within 12 months)
- Administrative transfers require District CTB Member concurrence
- Surplus Funds from Cancelled Revenue Sharing project cannot be transferred
- Transferred funds cannot be replaced through application process

REVENUE SHARING PROGRAM GUIDELINES REVISIONS

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- New Requirements for Allocation / Transfer Resulting from Updated CTB policy
- Clarifications as a result of CTB Policy Changes
- Changes to Reflect Revised Application Processes
- Clarification of Existing Policies / Procedures



REVENUE SHARING PROGRAM GUIDELINES (Next Steps)

- CTB approval of revised Guidelines
 - Approval of Policy and Guidelines at July CTB Meeting
 - Proposed Effective by August 1, 2017
 - Will apply to applications submitted for FY2019 and forward
- Application Process for Localities for FY 2019
 - Early August e-mail to localities with invitation for applications
 - 2 Year Cycle/Submitted through Smart Portal
 - November 1st Application Submittal Deadline



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
