



Assistant County Attorneys

Rockingham County is accepting resumes and applications for two positions of Assistant County Attorney. One position will be a full-time, in-house position and the second will be a part-time, contract position. To be qualified for either position, a candidate must be licensed to practice law in Virginia, have at least five years' litigation experience and have solid knowledge of laws relating to child abuse and neglect, foster care, and adult protective services, and be able to provide representation in a variety of matters to the Harrisonburg-Rockingham County Department of Social Services. Representation of the Department of Social Services will include appearing in the juvenile and circuit courts of Harrisonburg and Rockingham County, as well as the appellate courts of the Commonwealth. The full-time position may, from time-to-time, be called upon to assist the County Attorney on a broad range of matters unrelated to Social Services. The full-time position will be salaried commensurate with the experience level of the candidate and receive full benefits of a County employee. The part-time position will require approximately 10-12 hours per week initially. Should the position consistently require 15 hours or more per week, it may transition to a fulltime position. The part-time attorney will be an independent contractor paid at a fixed hourly rate commensurate with the attorney's experience. Both positions report to the County Attorney and work closely with the Social Services staff.
