

CONSTRUCTION INSPECTOR III

The Chesapeake Public Work's department is seeking a Construction Inspector III with a minimum of three years of experience.

Typical tasks include but are not limited to:

Responsible for coordinating with contractors, builders and developers to conduct routine ESC and Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) inspections of residential subdivision, multi-family, single-family, and commercial properties under construction.

Investigate ESC and SWPPP violations. Prepare and maintain inspection reports and records while assisting supervisor with pre-construction meetings. Maintain inspection and enforcement records within the Environmental Quality Services (EQS) Customer Service Request (CSR) permit tracking system.

Requires the ability to traverse various terrains and the ability to read and interpret construction plans, plats, construction record drawings, building and land disturbing permits, Virginia Pollution Discharge Elimination System (VPDES) construction general permits (VAR10), Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plans (SWPPP), regulations, codes, and ordinances. Ability to mentor and assist supervisor with coordination of subordinate inspection staff.

VOCATIONAL/EDUCATIONAL:

Requires an associate's degree or any equivalent combination of education and experience in civil engineering or a closely related field.

SPECIAL CERTIFICATIONS AND LICENSES:

Requires a valid driver's license and a driving record that is in compliance with City Driving Standards.

Requires DEQ Combined Erosion and Sediment Control and Stormwater Management Inspector Certifications
