SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Possession of a valid driver's license; possess and maintain a driving record that meets the County's established [Driver Eligibility and Driving Standards](#) as stated in Administrative Policy, Section 620.5.
- Pass a post-offer, pre-employment physical; position subject to subsequent physical examinations to ensure incumbent meets physical job requirements.
- Must be available to work off-hours due to situation severity or to minimize end-user downtime.
- For your application to be considered, you must attach your cover letter and resume to your on-line application.
