The Campbell County Department of Community Development is looking for a motivated, detail oriented, and customer service oriented candidate to fill the position of Environmental Code Enforcement Officer I.

This position is responsible for assisting the Environmental Manager in the day to day operations of the Environmental Program including but not limited to:

- Enforcing the provisions of the Commonwealth's Erosion and Sediment Control and Stormwater Programs and local ordinances;
- Comprehending, interpreting, and enforcing state and local erosion and sediment control, stormwater, biosolids, and other environmental ordinances;
- Independently inspecting residential and commercial construction sites for code compliance and keeping records of all inspections;
- Independently inspecting existing stormwater management facilities for compliance and keeps records of all inspections;
- Assisting the public calling or visiting the office, providing permit application information and issues permits;
- Performing daily inspections and monitoring on active biosolid sites, and keeping records of inspections;
- Possessing the required knowledge, skills and abilities to operate computer systems;
- Preparing and presenting cases in court for violation of applicable codes;
- Maintaining the care and cleanliness of all vehicles assigned to you.

This position requires completion of two (2) years of college or graduation from a business college, plus additional college level course work in related programs, as well as one (1) year experience in related field. Additional education and/or training may be substituted where applicable.
