12:00 p.m. Press Briefing - 12/7/2010

Good afternoon...I am Chief Ray Lavinder of the Roanoke County Police.

I would first like say thank you to the many people in Roanoke County and the region who have contacted us with tips and information concerning this ongoing investigation.

We are still actively searching for 12-year-old Brittany Mae Smith and 32-year-old Jeffrey Scott Easley.

The search for this 12-year-old middle school student began

Monday morning after our officers were called to the residence at 3341 Fort Lewis Circle in Roanoke County around 9:30 a.m. for a well-being check.

When our officers entered the home they found the body of 41-year-old Tina Smith.

Co-workers contacted us after Ms.

Smith failed to show up for work on

Sunday and again Monday.

While at the scene, we determined that a female child who lived at the home was missing.

The missing child is Tina Smith's 12-year-old daughter, Brittany, a seventh grade student at Glenvar Middle School here in the county.

Police say Tina and Brittany Smith were last seen in the area Friday morning – December 3.

Tina's car – a 2005 Silver Dodge

Neon with Virginia tags – was also
missing from the house.

We are confident that Brittany is with 32-year-old Jeffrey Scott Easley.

Easley was a friend of the family.

Tina and Jeff apparently met online this summer and developed a friendship.

Jeff moved in with Tina and Brittany in October.

We are extremely concerned for Brittany's safety and have asked State Police to extend the AMBER Alert for another 24 hours.

Easley is described as a white male with brown hair and hazel eyes and he may have a goatee.

He's five feet 11 inches tall and weighs 265 pounds.

Easley was last seen in the area Friday evening and works for a local landscaping company.

He does have family in eastern

North Carolina and Alabama.

Our investigation into Tina's death is also ongoing.

The Office of the Medical Examiner is conducting an autopsy and examination this morning, which we hope will help us better determine a cause and time of death.

We are still hopeful for Brittany's safe return... and are asking the public to please focus on the silver Dodge Neon and the photos and descriptions of Brittany and Jeff.
