SUMMARY

Accessibility of Local Government Leaders is an issue for many citizens throughout the United States. Carroll County has taken steps in curtailing this issue by implementation of QR Codes to County Business Cards and placement of those on the County website. QR Codes were implemented for the previous Board of Supervisors, current Board of Supervisors, County Administrator and Assistant County Administrator. The QR Codes for the County Administrator and the Assistant County Administrator are specifically for contact information and allow citizens to have that information at their fingertips. This also allows them to carry fewer cards, but still be able to get their information to others. With the QR Code printed on their business cards they are able to share their information quickly by scanning the code and having a contact created instantly into a cellular phone, IPAD, etc. The QR Codes for the Board of Supervisors include not only their contact information, but their biography as well. These codes are printed on the back of their business cards and link back to their biography which is located on the Carroll County website at www.carrollcountyva.org. This allows citizens to become familiar with each Board Member individually. The County has also began to link the Board Goals and the Comprehensive Plan Strategies by their associated numbers to each agenda item. This has allowed citizens to become familiar with the goals that are established each year by the County as well as the Comprehensive Plan Strategies that will lead the County over the next 20 years. This entry fulfills the award criteria as it is a model for other localities.

SITUATION

Government leader accessibility is important to the citizens that they serve. In the absence of accessibility, citizens become frustrated regarding their concerns while leaving issues unresolved. Carroll County has taken steps to become more accessible to all through the implementation of QR Codes as well as linking Board Goals and Comprehensive Plan Strategies to the Board of Supervisors meeting agenda.

FINANCING/STAFFING

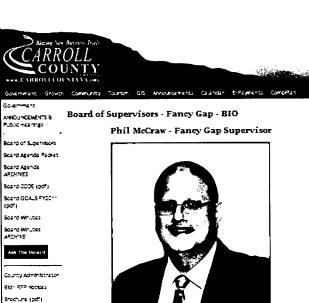
The County IT Department generated all of our QR Codes in house at no cost. The biographies were placed on our County website so when the codes are scanned it takes you directly to that page. The net cost to implement the QR project was \$80/1000 cards. The return on investment has been very positive as well as being seen in the community as a technology leader rather than a follower. There has been no cost associated with the linking of Board Goals/Comprehensive Plan to the Board of Supervisors agenda.

PROGRAM RESULTS

Citizen input and communication is important to Carroll County. We have found that citizens are more informed of County business and better participation has been noted. Since implementation, we have found that the use of QR Codes is an inexpensive and effective way to make our government leaders more accessible. While business cards are still a time honored tradition, the addition of QR Codes allow the cards to be much more information packed and useful. Also, at the same time, County government is viewed as a leader in the use of technology to assist with local issues.


