Program Overview:

Henrico County Public Schools and the county of Henrico recognize that a healthy and sustainable environment is important to the well-being of its citizens. Educating our employees to recognize activities that impact our environment and training them to plan and respond appropriately are primary keys to the success of our organizational commitment to sustainability. Henrico County Public Schools (HCPS) has developed and implemented an Environmental and Sustainability Management System (ESMS) as a management tool to document and measure the organization's environmental performance and sustainability. HCPS, through its Department of Construction and Maintenance, promotes and supports sustainability in its daily operations.
