- Working Group #1 is the Partnership between Chesterfield Schools and Chesterfield
- **Police.** The objectives and scope of work include: the current Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Chesterfield Schools and Chesterfield Police; School Resource Officers in Chesterfield schools; Communications Among Schools and Public Safety (to also include Chesterfield Fire and EMS); and, Discussion Regarding Chesterfield Police Protocols for Arrests on School Property—to include discussion of protocol for arrests for off-property behavior
- Working Group #2 is School Safety. The objectives and scope of work include: Role of Chesterfield Schools' Office of Safety and Security, Role of School Safety Officers, Critical Incident and Emergency Management Planning, Individual School Prevention Efforts, Visitor Management System and Visitor policies, Interior and Exterior Security/Video Cameras, and Video/Door Bell-Entrance System.

- * Working Group #3 is School Conduct and Student Discipline. The objectives and scope of work include: Chesterfield Schools Code of Student Conduct, Required By Law Reporting to Law Enforcement, Student Disciplinary Actions and Discipline Disparities, Alternative Approaches/Education for Student Discipline, and Bullying Prevention.
- Working Group #4 is Student Support Services. The objectives and scope of work include:

 Role of School Division Personnel (school counselors, psychologists and social workers),

 Partnership with Chesterfield County—to include Chesterfield County Mental Health,

 Chesterfield County Social Services, Community Services Board; Suicide Awareness and

 Prevention Efforts; Drugs in School and Opioid Crisis; and, Online Safety and

 Cybersecurity/Privacy
