QUALIFICATIONS:

Required: Graduation from an accredited school of law; active member of the Virginia State Bar in good standing.

In addition to Required:

Acceptable qualifications include: 6 months to 3 years experience in the practice of law with a concentration in civil, criminal, administrative or governmental law; or recent law school graduate; or any equivalent combination of training and experience which provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities.

Preferred qualifications include: a minimum of 3 years experience as an Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney with completion of specialized training in addition to maintaining required CLE credits.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

A cover letter, current writing sample and resume must be submitted with the online application for consideration.
