Description:

Fauquier County is currently seeking a Planner I with a diverse skill set and able to perform a variety of responsible professional planning duties related to the County's current planning activities and long range planning initiatives. This position within the Planning Division of the Department of Community Development will undertake a variety of professional planning activities including reviewing land development applications and presenting them to the Board of Supervisors, Planning Commission and Board of Zoning Appeals; assisting in the development of comprehensive plans and small area plans; analyzing demographic and environmental information; and providing technical assistance. Other responsibilities include providing information and assistance to developers, the general public, and outside agencies related to planning and zoning policies and ordinances.

Minimum requirements include a Bachelor's degree in urban planning or a closely related field (Masters preferred), and a general knowledge of the principles and practices of current planning and long range planning in both rural and urban planning realms. Experience using GIS software to perform analysis and the ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing is desired. The ideal candidate will be able work both as a member of a project team as well as independently manage projects and applications.
