- Leading Maintenance Tech 1 and seasonal staff in the maintenance of athletic fields, park facilities and other County property.
- Mowing, trimming, laying out and marking fields for various sports events, trash pickup, general cleaning of grounds, restrooms, concession stands and snow removal.
- Care and routine maintenance of tools and equipment.
- Keeping daily records of tasks performed.
- This position will work primarily Monday through Friday 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM.; however work may be performed at varying hours, including some nights, weekends and holidays.
- This position requires working outdoors and the ability to perform moderate to strenuous physical activity throughout the work day.

- 2 years' experience operating equipment associated with parks and sports field maintenance (examples: tractor, various mowers (zero turn, reel, push and walk behind), aerator, truck and trailer, roller and ventrac.
- Basic knowledge of equipment and maintenance, ability to troubleshoot minor problems such as, belts, filters, batteries and spark plugs.
- Ability to develop and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers, the general public and other County staff.
