

SURRY COUNTY JOB OPPORTUNITY

Surry County is seeking an Equipment Operator II. Work will be performed under the supervision of the Solid Waste and Recycling Supervisor and will include the following typical tasks:

Performs difficult semiskilled work operating, maintaining and repairing heavy equipment and machinery in the collection and disposal of solid waste, and related work as apparent or assigned.

Essential Functions

- Operates refuse truck on an assigned route picking up refuse; operates other landfill and construction equipment as assigned.
- Operates hydraulic mechanisms for compressing and dumping refuse; places and compacts refuse and covers with earth.
- Transports load to prescribed disposal areas.
- Performs pre-trip inspections; makes minor repairs and performs preventative maintenance duties on equipment such as changing oil, tires and greasing.
- Cleans refuse truck and equipment.
- Maintains landfill and refuse sites: cleans around containers.
- Assists with construction, repair and maintenance of County facilities and grounds; performs landscaping and mows grass as necessary; and
- Other duties as assigned.

General knowledge of the principles and practices of operating and servicing heavy construction and landfill equipment; general knowledge of the traffic laws and regulations governing equipment operation; general knowledge of the occupational hazards involved and the safety precautions necessary for the proper operation of varied construction and maintenance equipment; skill and care in the operation of several types of construction equipment; ability to understand and follow oral and written directions; mechanical aptitude; ability to make minor repairs and adjustments to equipment; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationship with associates and the general public.

High school diploma or GED and considerable experience in the operation and maintenance of heavy equipment, or equivalent combination of education and experience. Valid Commercial driver's license with Class B endorsement in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
