
COVID-19 Unified Command Task Force



COVID- 19 Unified Command Task Force Objectives

- MONITORING: Conduct monitoring, surveillance and assessment on the spread of COVID-19, to include the development of tracking tools and dashboards for Virginia.
- PREVENTION & CONTAINMENT: Initiate appropriate strategies to prevent and contain the spread of COVID-19 in Virginia.
- Screening: Initiate standard screening process as a secondary prevention method
- TREATMENT: Ensure suspected or confirmed patients with COVID-19 are treated appropriately.
- COMMUNICATIONS: Communicate to the public, business community, and state employees in a transparent and consistent means across state government.
- PLANNING: Review, assess, and develop contingency plans for
 - supplies and PPE
 - medical surge
 - telework
 - trigger points for (A) public health emergency requiring quarantine or isolation; (B) state emergency declaration; and (C) limitations on mass gatherings, schools, and/or transportation.
 - COOP & COG
- TRAINING, EDUCATION and EXERCISE: Identify and provide training, education and exercise materials to state employees and response partners.
- POLICY GUIDANCE: Provide consistent policy guidance across state government.
- COSTS: Track financial costs for COVID-19
- Work force health and safety: establish appropriate measures for the safety and wellness of state workforce.
