GROUNDS MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR

The City of Manassas Public Works Grounds Maintenance Department is looking for an energetic and results-driven leader that enjoys working outdoors. The individual in this position will be responsible for routine ground maintenance around the Airport facilities; ensuring the safety of airport personnel, contract workers and the general public.

Hiring Range for the individual hired for this position:

\$52,852.80 - \$70,012.80

The successful incumbent in this role will be required to handle the following on a regular basis:

Operate commercial mowers, trimmers, edger, blowers, etc. Maintains airport grounds: Mows airport owned properties, runways, and taxiways; plants, trims, edges and weeds beds; trims trees in aircraft approach lanes and roadways; and performs pesticide and herbicide control on airport owned buildings and properties including terminal building, control tower, hangars, fence lines, ditches, trees, and turf.

Performs maintenance on grounds keeping equipment: Changes oils and greases parts; performs tune ups; sharpens/replaces blades; performs welding on damaged areas of mowing decks for safety; replaces hydraulic lines and valves; adjusts brakes; and replaces snow plow blades and broom bristles.

Perform snow removal on Airport sidewalks, buildings, grounds, and medians with snow blowers and snow shovels; responds to emergency calls during inclement weather or other emergency situations.

High school diploma or GED; previous experience in maintenance of public infrastructure is preferred; or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience that provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities. Requires the ability to operate, maneuver and/or control the actions of equipment, machinery, tools, and/or materials used in performing essential functions.

Must possess a Valid VA Driver's License. Must have or be able to obtain a Virginia Class B CDL (Commercial Driver's License) and a Virginia Pesticide Applicator License within five months of hire.
