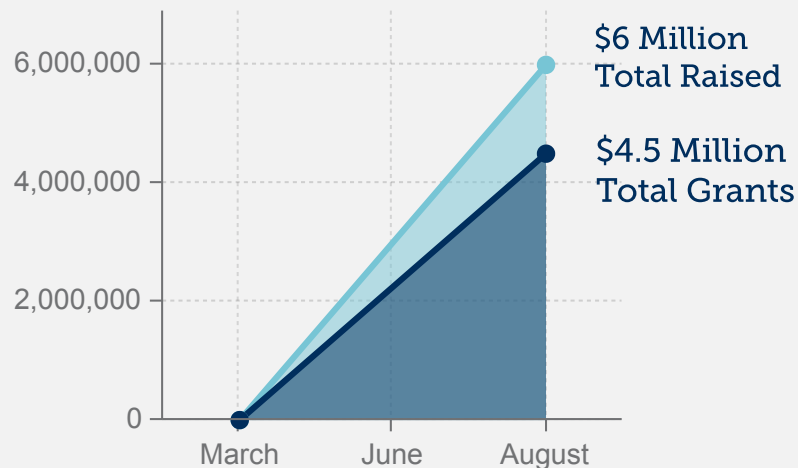


FUND OVERVIEW
