The Grounds Maintenance Technician performs routine maintenance and construction for parks and recreation buildings, athletic fields and facilities and equipment.

Responsibilities:

- Performing routine maintenance on athletic fields, park facilities and other County properties for sports and general citizen use
- Mowing, trimming, laying out and marking fields for various sports, trash pickup, general cleaning of grounds, restrooms, concession stands and snow removal
- Equipment operation, including but not limited to tractors, skid steer, utility vehicles and bunker rakes

- General construction tools, hand-held power tools and maintenance equipment with safe work practices
- General math and computation skills to calculate measurements, ratios, differences, etc.
- Basic knowledge of sports and recreation programs
