

Report of VACo's Resolutions Committee Meeting
Monday, November 9, 2020

1. **Committee on Economic Development and Planning (Pp. 2-3)**

Unchanged from 2021 Draft Legislative Program.

2. **Committee on Education (Pp. 4-6)**

p. 5, line 205, insert new position that reads as follows:

"School Consolidation and Regionalism

VACo supports additional state resources and incentives that allow counties to voluntarily consolidate or regionalize K-12 services to increase operational efficiencies."

p. 5, line 213, strike "hire additional Resource Officers, School Protection Officers, and other security and mental health personnel and measures." and replace with "make investments in security and health."

p.5, line 215, strike "allow for the placement of Resource Officer and Protection Officers in schools." and replace with "to implement appropriate security measures."

3. **Energy Subcommittee (P. 7)**

p.7, line 383, insert "gas" after "natural".

4. **Committee on Environment and Agriculture (Pp. 8-11)**

p. 10, line 454, after "such as," insert "Virginia Soil and Water Conservation Districts (SWCDs),"

5. **Committee on Finance (Pp. 12-13)**

p.12, line 510, after "supports," insert "preserving"

6. **Committee on General Government (Pp. 14-15)**

p. 14, line 616, insert new sentence at the end of the paragraph that reads as follows: "VACo opposes changes to state-mandated funding formulas that decrease state funding and require increased local funding."

p. 14, lines 624-625, strike ". . . decrease the costs of elections to localities. These costs include . . ." Replace with the following language: "increase state investments in elections. This includes funding and support for . . ."

p.15, line 677, delete “defense” and insert “defenses of qualified immunity and”

7. **Committee on Health and Human Resources** (Pp. 16-19)

Unchanged from 2021 Draft Legislative Program.

8. **Committee on Transportation** (Pp. 20-22)

Unchanged from 2021 Draft Legislative Program.
