The person must also be well versed in evidence-based, trauma-informed strategies and interventions.

The desired candidate must be an excellent communicator who can communicate effectively with various entities including judges, state and local officials, parents, detainees and community partners. He or she should have a demonstrated record of having developed community partnerships that resulted in programs/services for the detainees and their families. Experience with working with a diverse advisory board is desirable.
