Additionally, the selected candidate will work with consultants, Architecture/Engineering firms, and code officials to produce engineering studies, and will design for a variety of facility projects; will work with City customers to design and construct renovations in City facilities, and with Purchasing to develop/update specifications for IDIQ maintenance contracts (plumbing, HVAC, electrical, etc.).
