DESCRIPTION:	

Isle of Wight County is currently recruiting for the position of Pump Station Mechanic with the Department of Public Utilities (in the Sewer Division). The Pump Station Mechanic troubleshoots problems at pumpstations, installs new equipment, and performs preventative maintenance in order to ensure proper operation of pump stations.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

- Installs, repairs, and performs routine maintenance of sewer pump stations;
- Identifies failures and makes repairs to sewer pump stations;
- Monitors and observes activities of various contractors hired to install pump stations;
- Operates a variety of equipment and tools used on the maintenance of pump stations;
- Performs general/preventative maintenance tasks to ensure proper operation of pump stations;
- Inspects and tests systems to identify cause of problems and to ensure proper operation;
- Compiles a record for the history of pump stations and all repairs.
- Provides response to after-hours emergency calls or emergency situations;
- Prepares reports, forms, work orders, and miss utility tickets;
- Follows safety procedures and monitors work environment to ensure safety of co-workers;
- Performs other related duties as assigned.
- Observe all approved safety and health policies and procedures pertaining to his/her work activities and perform all work tasks in a safe and healthy manner in accordance with County policy.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

The work is heavy work: Exerting up to 100 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 50 pounds of force frequently, and/or up to 50 pounds of force constantly to move objects. Requires the use of fingers, climbing, crawling, crouching, grasping, hearing, kneeling, kneeling, lifting, mental acuity, pulling, pushing, reaching, repetitive motion, speaking, stooping, and visual acuity.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Education and Experience:

Requires a High School Diploma/ GED, and two (2) years of work experience.

Licenses or Certifications:

Requires a valid commercial driver's license Class A or must obtain within six (6) months of employment.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Knowledge of operation and maintenance requirements in order to operate sewer pump stations;
- Ability to use or repair small/light equipment, such as power tools; Ability to operate heavy or complex machinery, such as ability to use or repair medium equipment and machinery, such as vehicles or pumps, generators, and jetter machines; backhoes and trenchers;
- Ability to operate and perform maintenance and repairs to sewer pump stations.
- Must be able to enter and work in confined spaces for a minimum of 20 minutes on a regular basis.

SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION:

Position is open until filled.

Please Note: All County employees may be required to report to serve our customers during emergency conditions. While some will perform their regular duties, others may be assigned to report at a different time and location and to perform different duties from their regular jobs.

Employees will either be deemed essential personnel and provide services that must continue regardless of or pursuant to a state of emergency or will be deemed nonessential personnel that will be required to report to work in an emergency if they receive an assignment to shelter duty or other duty.
