Montgomery County has openings for Part-Time Recycling Attendant(s). Responsibilities include: opening and closing recycling centers at designated times; notifying supervisor when bins are full; assisting users of recycling facility with proper disposal of trash and recyclables; and keeping site tidy and free of debris. Requires routine manual work; ability to lift/carry/manipulate loads up to 50 pounds safely, walk/push/pull items on irregular terrain, work under varying weather conditions, and understand/follow simple oral instructions. Requires valid Virginia Driver License and good driving record. Must have ability to read instructions/hazardous chemical warnings and write to complete standard forms and reports. Completion of high school/GeD or combination of experience and training to ensure the required knowledge, skills and abilities outlined. High customer service abilities are a must.

Pay \$10.27/hr, up to 24 hrs/week. Position requires flexible scheduling including evenings and weekends.
