Performs complex advanced protective services work planning, directing, and supervising the overall operations of the department, handling personnel and public information matters, coordinating work with City Manager and department directors, ensuring that all laws, regulations, and procedures are followed, maintaining appropriate records and files, and related work as apparent or assigned. Work involves setting policies and goals. Supervision is exercised over all personnel within the department.

## **EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:**

- Plans, organizes, and oversees the department personnel management; recruits, hires, assigns, and directs work; trains, transfers, promotes, suspends, terminates, disciplines, evaluates performance, counsels, and develops staff schedules.
- Plans, organizes, and manages the operations of the department to include policies and procedures formulation and enforcement, budget preparation and control (fire stations, equipment, supplies, and other assets).
- Oversees fire safety information and education, as well as fire prevention programs.
- Performs long-term planning regarding fire protection services, emergency services, etc., for the department.
- Develops and evaluates the department program effectiveness; recommends appropriate changes.
- Prepares and maintains various reports for executive management and for compliance with regulatory State and National requirements.
- Attends various meetings or functions to represent the department and the City; promotes mutual aid and working relationships with regional fire agencies; remains current on regulations and programs standards.
- Responds to all major incidents and directs firefighting operations and strategies; plans and coordinates activities around natural and manmade disasters.

• Bachelor's degree in fire administration, public administration, or related field and extensive experience in fire and emergency services including supervisory experience, or

equivalent combination of education and experience.
