**Responsibilities:** The Engineering Technician reviews assigned construction plans and submittals for conformance to Service Authority standards. Serves as Service Authority representative on construction projects and coordinates with field personnel, engineers, contractors, and other stakeholders. Performs construction inspections and testing for water and sanitary sewer system construction projects to ensure compliance with Service Authority Standards. Uses GPS and other survey equipment, as needed, to locate existing utilities and record locations of newly constructed infrastructure. Assists with the preparation of drawings for projects.
