The Streets Maintenance Superintendent is responsible for assisting in planning, organizing, directing, and supervising the activities of Street Department crews doing maintenance work related to street and roadside repairs, stormwater maintenance, snow removal routes, leaf collection, street sweeping, etc. Supervises directs, evaluates and develops staff; manages and directs projects and work orders, oversees emergency operations, oversees use of owned and rented equipment, responds to citizen inquiries, and performs other administrative tasks.

Minimum Required Qualifications:

Associate's degree in related field

Five years' experience in road maintenance AND

Three years of superintendent/supervisory experience of multiple crews
