

GENERAL REGISTRAR & DIRECTOR OF ELECTIONS

The department has a budget of over \$1.7 million and employees 8 full-time employees, 17 part-time employees and numerous temporary, seasonal Officer of Elections. The General Registrar & Director of Elections reports to the three-member Electoral Board and collaborates with Chesterfield County leadership through the Deputy County Administrator for Finance and Administration.

The General Registrar & Director of Elections is responsible for the operation of the Registrar's Office, to include:

- plan, organize and execute of local, state and federal elections for Chesterfield County
- administer the provisions of the Commonwealth of Virginia's election laws under guidelines established by the State Board of Elections and Chesterfield County Electoral Board
- oversee the day-to-day operations of the Registrar's Office, to include, administration and maintenance of voter registration in accordance with the State Board of Election guidelines
- manage the election security and operations at all voting locations and maintenance of the security of election procedures and equipment, including testing of equipment
- facilitate voter education and public outreach to ensure transparency and accessibility of election activities
- ensure compliance with applicable local, state and federal laws for the electoral process
- promote and implementation of best practices to ensure efficient voter registration and election procedures and the provision of appropriate certification and training for staff, including officers of election
- serve as the principal spokesperson for disseminating information to the news media, political parties, candidates, and general public

Applicants must possess a bachelor's degree in business administration, public administration or related field is required; master's degree is preferred. Minimum of five years of progressively responsible managerial and leadership experience including three years of experience in a supervisory/leadership capacity, or an equivalent combination of training and experience. Virginia Registered Elections Officials (VREO) certification preferred. The successful candidate must be, or become within 30 days of appointment, a registered voter residing in Chesterfield County.

Ideal candidate will have excellent leadership and communication skills and proven experience in managing a complex election process in a large organization

Good driving record, pre-employment drug test and extensive background check required.
