Description:

Under close supervision, this position performs a variety of custodial duties in the care and maintenance of County buildings and facilities. The work involves using a variety of procedures, power and hand equipment, and supplies to maintain buildings in a neat, sanitary, presentable manner. The employee must exercise some independent judgment in completion of assigned tasks that are subject to inspection. This position reports to the Custodial Supervisor.

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

Knowledge of large building cleaning practices, procedures, supplies and equipment.

Ability to use cleaning supplies and equipment economically and efficiently.

Ability to lift and maneuver cleaning supplies, tools.

Qualifications:

High school diploma/GED.

Some experience in custodial work, including the use of heavy floor stripping, waxing, and buffing equipment preferred.

Special Requirements:

Possession of a valid driver's license; possess and maintain a driving record that meets established Gloucester County Driving Standards.

This position must pass, an enhanced background check, including fingerprint tracing to access secure spaces as necessary and a post-offer, pre-employment physical. The position is subject to subsequent physical examinations to ensure incumbent meets physical job requirements.
