As the Aquatics Program Supervisor, you will:

- Provide leadership in the planning and implementation of aquatic programs by inspiring innovation and creativity of staff and providing direction in modern recreation programming and planning;
- Perform lifeguarding and instructional duties as required;
- Evaluate current practices and procedures for accomplishing department objectives to develop and implement improved service delivery;
- Perform supervisory responsibilities in accordance with City policies, procedures, and applicable laws;
- Provide support in the development and implementation of facility emergency action plans and safety, including staff training in CPR, First Aid, and Lifeguarding;
- Maintain inventory of first aid and rescue equipment and supplies, conduct daily opening, closing, and facility safety inspection checklists, replenish or replace supplies and equipment as needed, and prepare or process purchase orders for pool supplies and equipment;
- Maintain the appearance and cleanliness of aquatic facilities, including the pool, deck, storage rooms, pump rooms, and restrooms;
- Conduct water quality testing and monitor water quality to ensure compliance with established water quality standards, including adjusting chemicals as needed;
- Perform routine maintenance on filtration systems and calibrate automated controllers as needed;
- Inspect and maintain chemical feed system, pool fittings, plumbing, and hardware;
- Advise your manager of safety and repair needs and concerns immediately;
- Review and analyze reports, records, and directives and confer with the Aquatic Manager to
 obtain data required for planning activities, such as new commitments, status of work in
 progress, and problems encountered;

- Create/maintain pertinent training information, including coordinating required training of assigned staff, ensuring assigned staff completes trainings, and preparing and maintaining appropriate files and records;
- Monitor department assets, conducts facility maintenance inspections, and implements corrective courses of action regarding facility maintenance, furniture, fixtures, equipment, and more;
- Develop and ensure quality and safety standards are met;
- · Open and close the operations of the facility;
- Oversee and assist with a variety of operational and maintenance duties.
