Duties include staff supervision, training, instruction, scheduling, and evaluation; understanding and interpreting library policy for the public and staff; assisting Library Branch Manager with the day-to-day operation of the library including facility maintenance and planning; collection development; workflow design and improvement; modeling a sustained positive, respectful team environment; using the library automated system, the internet, library databases, and reference materials to provide direct public service; performing basic and advanced library circulation tasks; planning and delivering library programming; maintaining responsibility for the safe operation of the facility in the Branch Manager's absence; and performing other duties as assigned. Some evening, Saturday and Sunday hours in rotation are required. Bachelor's Degree in a related field or equivalent is required; Library experience preferred.
