Successful candidate will possess a bachelor's degree in civil or environmental engineering or related field and six years of experience in the operation and maintenance of a wastewater treatment plant including three years of supervisory experience; or an equivalent combination of training and experience. Possession of a valid Class I Wastewater Operator's Certificate issued by the Commonwealth of Virginia. Considerable knowledge of federal effluent permit requirements (NPDES); of supervisory principles and practices; of the principle practices of wastewater treatment; planning laboratory testing strategies; of the latest advances in wastewater treatment. Current valid driver's license and good driving record required. Based on the Virginia DMV point system, record must not reflect a total of six or more demerit points within the twenty-four months preceding the anticipated hire date, or one major violation of six demerit points within the preceding thirty-six months. Out of state driving records must be obtained by applicant and presented at time of interview. Records must reflect at least three years of history and be dated within thirty days of interview date.
