

Combination Building Inspector Full Time

Inspector. The Combination Building Inspector performs residential and non-residential inspections identifying deficiencies with the contractor or owner for correction. This position is responsible for corresponding both written and verbally with architects, contractors, builders, County personnel, and the general public regarding building codes, ordinances, regulations, policies and procedures. This position may assist with scheduling appointments, reviewing, and approving plans in compliance with building codes, ordinances, and regulations.

Position must maintain a comprehensive knowledge and understand the principles and practices of building, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and cross-connection code enforcement as well as erosion and sediment control laws and procedures. Any combination of education and experience which would confer equivalent knowledge and ability shall be deemed to satisfy this requirement. Ability to read, interpret, apply, and explain building plans, blueprints, specifications, and building codes; use word processing and other related computer software programs; prepare and maintain complete, accurate, and concise reports and records. Maintain general knowledge and basic understanding of Franklin County's zoning ordinances and policies. Maintain comprehensive knowledge and understanding of the Plans Examiner position, policies, and practices.
