Park Monitor – Part-Time

This position provides a safe and enjoyable recreational experience for park users. **Minimum Qualifications:** High school graduation or equivalent; with one (1) to three (3) months related experience and/or training; or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience. Must be at least 18 years old. **Salary: \$11.00 per hour**

Emergency Communications Operator I – Full-Time

An employee in this position serves as an Emergency Communications Operator in training (ECOI-T) for the Culpeper County Public Safety Communication's Center (Center.) The ECOI-T works as an essential staff member, being the first of the first responders that the community interacts with in reporting emergencies in Culpeper County. **Minimum Qualifications:** Education & Experience equivalent to a high school diploma or GED. See the job posting for additional requirements. **Salary: \$32,280.53 - \$50,034.82 annually**

Emergency Communications Operator II – Full-Time

An employee in this position serves as the Communications Training Operator (ECOII) for the Culpeper County Public Safety Communication's Center (Center), who shall act on the Shift Supervisor's behalf during his/her absence or as delegated/designated. The ECOII assists in the training of new employees and continuing education of all other shift personnel. The ECOII works as an essential staff member, being the first of the first responders that the community interacts with in reporting emergencies in Culpeper County.**Minimum Qualifications:** Education & Experience equivalent to a high school diploma or GED. See the job posting for additional requirements. **Salary: \$35,998.13 - \$55,797.10 annually**

Firefighter/Emergency Medical Technician (ALS) – Full-Time

Responds to and provides services related to medical, trauma, rescue, and fire-related emergencies. Also performs additional emergency services work as required. Much of the work is performed under emergent conditions. Position is considered essential personnel. **Minimum Qualifications:** Education & experience equivalent to a (1) high school diploma; (2) completion of EMT Intermediate/Paramedic training; and (3) two years previous experience and/or training in EMS field. **Salary: \$47,876.32** -**\$66,779.81 annually**

Convenience Site Attendant – Full-Time and Part-Time available

Facilitates daily operations of the solid waste drop-off convenience center and performs related duties as required. **Minimum Qualifications:** High school graduation or equivalent, or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience. **Salary: \$11.00 - \$16.74 per hour**

Transfer Station Scale Operator – Full-Time

Water/Wastewater Operators I, II, III, or IV– Full-Time

Performs a variety of duties related to the operation and maintenance of water and wastewater plants in accordance with State and Federal water quality regulations. Day shift only. Duties and responsibilities vary slightly depending upon licensure level. **Minimum Qualifications:** High

school diploma or GED **Salary:** Pay is based on licensure level attained by the employee.

<u>Wastewater Operators II, III – Full-Time</u>

Performs a variety of duties related to the operation and maintenance of water and wastewater plants in accordance with State and Federal water quality regulations. Day shift only.

Duties and responsibilities vary slightly depending upon licensure level. **Minimum Qualifications:** High school diploma or GED **Salary:** \$53,578.80 - \$72,299.85

Water Operator II – Full-Time

Performs a variety of duties related to the operation and maintenance of water and wastewater plants in accordance with State and Federal water quality regulations. Day shift only. Duties and responsibilities vary slightly depending upon licensure level. **Minimum Qualifications:** High

school diploma or GED Salary: \$59,472.46 - \$72,299.85

Line Service Technician – Part-Time

Performs customer service, fueling, and general maintenance duties for the County airport. **Minimum Qualifications:** Education and experience equivalent to a high school diploma. Some experience fueling aircrat and/or working as a cashier is preferred. **Salary:** \$11.99 - \$18.58 per hour
