Under general supervision, performs work of routine difficulty in fabricating and installing street signs and other signage. Designs and formats sign layouts using computerized graphic software; fabricates signs in accordance with federal and state specifications; installs, repairs, and maintains street signage; operates power saws, drills, routers, pneumatic tools, jigs and other related tools used in the sign fabrication trade; maintains and requisitions stock items to be used in the building and repair of signs; schedules work within the sign shop; maintains and prepares a variety of production records and activity reports. Perform other work as required. **PLEASE NOTE: Position open until filled (first review to begin September 12, 2022).**

Successful candidate will possess a high school diploma or GED; one year of experience in sign fabrication, sheet metal work or other related work; or an equivalent combination of training and experience. Working knowledge of the tools, equipment, materials, and methods used in the fabrication and installation of street signs; of federal and state regulations governing highway sign manufacturing. Ability to use hand power tools; to read and interpret maps, property plats, and construction plans; to perform physically demanding work including, but not limited to, heavy lifting, standing for prolonged periods, squatting, stooping, bending, twisting, stretching, crawling, reaching overhead, and working in awkward positions without choice or variety; to communicate effectively orally and in writing: to utilize a personal computer and related software and other standard office equipment; to develop and maintain effective working relationships with internal and external customers. Current valid driver's license and good driving record required. Based on the Virginia DMV point system, record must not reflect a total of six or more demerit points within the twenty-four months preceding the anticipated hire date, or one major violation of six demerit points within the preceding thirty-six months.
