Qualifications:

Minimum Qualifications at the Assistant Engineer (EIT) level. Applicants must:

- Possess a bachelor's degree in civil engineering, civil engineering technology, or a related field.
- Have prior work/internship experience for municipal projects.
- Possess appropriate professional certification, EIT or EI, or be able to obtain within 6 months of hire.

Minimum Qualifications at the Civil Engineer I level. Applicants must:

- Possess a bachelor's degree in civil engineer, civil engineering technology, or a related field.
- Have one (1) to three (3) years of experience preferred in civil engineering, or a related field, including one (1) to two (2) years of project management experience.
- Civil Engineering degree accredited by the Engineering Accreditation Commission of ABET, and/or Professional Engineer (PE) license is preferred.
- Possession of Engineering Training Certificate is required.

Special Requirements

To be considered for this position, your online application must include your cover letter, resume, and three (3) professional references.

Possession of a valid driver's license; possess and maintain a driving record that meets established Gloucester County Driving Standards.
