Requirements include: High School diploma or GED. Released as a Virginia Certified Emergency Medical Technician; ALS or Paramedic level is preferred. Considerable experience in EMS preferred. CPR and EVOIC certifications required. Virginia EMS Education Coordinator and Field Training Officer experience preferred. ACLS, ICS certifications of appropriate level and Hazardous Materials Awareness and Operations certifications required within 12 months of employment. Leadership and management training required within 12 months of employment. Valid driver's license and acceptable criminal and driving records. Successful candidate will have the ability to interface and coordinate with volunteer rescue squads.
