

PLANNER II

Fauquier County's Department of Community Development is seeking an experienced, motivated and multi-disciplined planner who is early in their career to join our team. This position within the Planning Division is responsible for providing project management and analysis of Special Permit, Special Exception and Rezoning applications; preparing Comprehensive Plan Amendments; analyzing environmental and demographic information; and providing technical assistance to citizens, developers, boards and commissions.

The Planner II will also assist with the review and design of the County's transportation plans, programs and projects, which may include coordinating the County's Revenue Share projects, Smart Scale applications, Secondary Road Six-Year Improvement Plan; reviewing Traffic Impact Analysis reports, and responding to citizen's requests.

Minimum requirements include any combination of education and experience equivalent to graduation from an accredited college or university with major course work in urban planning or a related field and some experience in professional planning work. Candidates with no or limited experience may be considered for hire as a Planner I, our entry-level position. Salary range is commensurate with qualifications and experience.
