The City of Fredericksburg is seeking an experienced, knowledgeable, and professional project manager for its Utility Projects Manager. This new position performs work under limited supervision, while maintaining a high level of customer service to all project stakeholders. Primary responsibilities include public utility project management and oversight for the development, design, and construction of utility maintenance projects, capital improvement projects, and emergency/unplanned projects, as well as assisting in the development and administration of a variety of water and sewer related programs. management of all phases of the project life-cycle process, from conception/initiation through closing, in order to deliver a specified product, service, system or result within the constraints of the project scope, resources, time and budget for various types of infrastructure projects. The position coordinates with other City departments and external organizations on projects and programs that may affect the City's water and sewer utilities.

Education, Experience and Credentials: A Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in Civil Engineering, Environmental Science, or other relevant field experience that provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities; combined with a minimum of three (3) years of continuous progressive experience in utility construction, operations, or project management, preferably within a local government setting. Licensed Professional Engineer (P.E.) in the State of Virginia required, or ability to obtain licensure within 6 months of date of hire. Preferred: 3-5 years' experience in direct/managing municipal public works operations & administration, or projects management, preferably in a local government setting.
