

King George County, "Gateway to the Historic Northern Neck," with its 131 miles of shoreline on the Potomac and Rappahannock Rivers, acres of unspoiled natural beauty, cultural diversities and historic wealth, is home to approximately 26,337 citizens who are proud of their past and excited about the community's future. The County covers approximately 113,920 acres (183 square miles), of which 72,718 acres are forested, and 38,105 acres are agricultural. King George County is a transitioning rural County steeped in history that places a high priority on quality of life through the protection of natural, cultural and historical resources as well as by being a regional leader in proactive and progressive planning, development and governmental services.

The Department of Community Development works diligently with various agencies, departments, and developers assisting the community with land development, geographic data, home improvement projects, and protecting the safety, health, and welfare of the residents of King George County through administering the VA Uniform Statewide Building Code. THE IDEAL CANDIDATE

The Community Development Director will be a conscientious leader that represents the department with integrity and professionalism. The selected candidate has the opportunity to make an impact on the community's future for quality development, and, therefore should have a creative vision for the big picture of King George County. The County values respect, integrity, teamwork, creativity, excellence, and is looking for a teammate who will demonstrate these values while advancing the County's mission.

The ideal candidate will be able to establish and maintain excellent working relationships based on leadership rather than authority. The Director will be open and willing to meet, listen, collaborate, and find solutions to planning and development challenges. With responsibility for the overall management of community development services, it is crucial that the selected candidate be a subject matter expert who can communicate complex ideas to a broad audience of varying levels of understanding.

Candidates should be experienced in navigating complex and political issues, and working effectively with advisory boards and commissions as well as public officials. The Director will serve as an ambassador of the organization to the community as well as businesses, developers, and other key stakeholders. Successful candidates will be able to communicate clearly and present professionally to a variety of groups. The Director must also demonstrate respect and sensitivity toward the diversity of the greater community.

Candidates will be expected to have a thorough knowledge of the theories, principles, and practices of public administration, especially as it relates to community and development activities; thorough working knowledge of planning, building, housing, residential, and commercial; and working knowledge of other County departments, particularly as their operations may relate to the Department. The Director will be both a collaborative and productive member of the County's Executive Team, with the ability to be strategic and pragmatic in approaching issues.

Candidates must possess a Bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college or university, preferably with a major in Engineering, Urban Planning, Public Administration, Business Administration, or a related field; possession of a Master's degree is <u>highly desirable</u>. A minimum of five (5) years of direct experience in the field with one to three (1-3) years of extensive, progressively responsible administrative and supervisory experience or any equivalent combination of education and experience that provides the knowledge, skills, and abilities is required.



JOB OVERVIEW

Reports to the County Administrator, the Community Development Director is a highly responsible professional position that plans, coordinates, and manages the operations of the Community Development Department; and develops and implements plans, policies, and programs to promote and increase residential and commercial activities with the County of King George. The Director is responsible for coordinating staff support to the Planning Commissions, Boards of Zoning Appeals, elected boards, and other commissions and committees.
