

Corporate Budget Director - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission

First review of applications will occur on August 16, 2023.

Founded in 1927, the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) is a nationally recognized leader in land use planning, parks, and recreation. The agency, which is chartered by the State of Maryland, has geographic authority in the Montgomery County and Prince George's County region, which are the two Maryland counties surrounding Washington, DC.

M-NCPPC's Corporate Budget Division is the distinguished winner of the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) Budget Presentation Award for the 38th year in a row. The Corporate Budget Director leads the Division, which provides agency-wide budgetary planning, analyses, and reporting, oversees the Commission's budget preparation process, and provides strategic information, central budget coordination, and fiscal planning for the agency. The Corporate Budget Director is an executive-level position reporting directly to the Executive Director and is responsible for creating the budget and associated financial reports for an agency with almost \$640 million in the General Fund budget for FY 2023.

The annual salary range for this position is \$107,141 to \$189,756. The starting salary will be commensurate with the successful candidate's experience and qualifications. The Commission provides a robust and highly competitive benefits program that includes Pension (and OPEB) Plan, additional available 457 Deferred Compensation Plan, Medical, Dental, Vision, and Life insurance, vacation and sick leave, flexible spending accounts, employee assistance and tuition assistance programs, and more.

This position requires a bachelor's degree in Finance, Accounting, Business Administration, Public Administration or any related field; and eight (8) years of progressively responsible experience that includes substantive work in the range of duties and responsibilities of the position. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be substituted, which together total twelve (12) years. Experience in local government is highly preferred.
