



However, the bylaws allow a county to designate a proxy to vote if a member of the Board of Supervisors cannot be present for this meeting. Counties should have received voting credential forms and proxy forms by mail in September. If you did not return your form to VACo in the mail, you can submit it to the VACo Credentials Committee at its meeting on Monday, November 13 at 1 p.m. in the Monroe room. You can also drop it off at the conference registration desk before the Credentials Committee meeting.

More than \$42 billion in federal funds will be disbursed to get more Americans fast and reliable internet access through the Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment Program (also known as BEAD). Virginia's allocation under BEAD is \$1.48 billion and will build upon the work of the Virginia Telecommunication Initiative (VATI) to reach the remaining unserved, and underserved, regions of the Commonwealth, This session will provide an overview of BEAD and how Virginia counties can partner with internet service providers in applying for BEAD dollars, including using State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds program, set up with the American Rescue Plan Act, as part of the required qualifying match.

# ISSUES IN K-12 EDUCATION FUNDING AND SCHOOL BOARD RELATIONS | Mount

Funding for K-12 education remains the largest funding item of a county government's budget. The recent report from the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission (JLARC) confirms what many in local government already know to be true: the State Standards of Quality (SOQ) formula yields substantially less funding than actual local school division spending and

benchmarks. Leaders in County Government and the President of the Virginia School Boards Association will share their thoughts on the state of K-12 education, what they think can be done better, and invite audience participation.


# Congratulations to the Virginia Certified County Supervisors' Program Class of 2023

# About the development and adoption of VACo's annual legislative program

- 1. In January the VACo President appoints VACo members to the eight VACo steering committees and names chairs and vice chairs. The eight steering committees are Agriculture and Rural Affairs; Community, Economic, and Workforce Development; Education; Environment, Energy, and Land Use; Finance and Elections; General Government; Health and Human Resources; and Transportation.
- **2.** VACo members are invited to attend regional meetings held April-September throughout the VACo regions in the Commonwealth to identify and discuss key legislative issues.
- 3. The steering committees meet once in late summer and again in November during the annual conference. The Steering Committees develop their position statements for the annual Legislative Program, based in part on information received during the regional meetings.
- **4.** In early Fall, prior to the annual conference, the membership receives a Preliminary Legislative Program. This draft is revised during the annual conference.
- **5.** The VACo Resolutions Committee oversees the development of the annual Legislative Program. It meets during the annual conference in November. The Resolutions Committee includes the six members of VACo's Executive Committee and the chairs and vice chairs of VACo's eight steering committees. VACo's President-Elect chairs the Resolutions Committee.
- **6.** The VACo membership adopts the new Legislative Program during the annual business meeting on the last day of the annual conference in November.
