Qualification Requirements

Thorough knowledge of the office methods, procedures and practices of a Virginia Court; thorough knowledge of business English, spelling and office management; ability to perform a considerable volume of detailed financial record work. Requires knowledge of and experience with project management, budget preparation, grant writing, ancillary service development, problem-solving court principles, substance use disorders, and serious mental illness. Possess general knowledge of human behavior, social science and rehabilitative techniques and objectives. Possess the ability to establish and maintain positive working relationships with Community Corrections, Judges and Courts, legal, law enforcement, clients, victims, families and the general public.

Special Requirements

Any combination of education and experience equivalent to graduation from an accredited college or university with major course work in criminal justice, public administration, sociology, psychology, counseling or some related field desired. A minimum of five years of experience in human services/criminal justice field required.
