As the Emergency Management Generalist, you'll play a critical role in the City's success by coordinating, planning, training, and preparing City staff in emergency preparedness as part of the Office of Emergency Management. Additionally, you'll provide assistance in evaluating internal and external agency emergency action plans and periodically measure, evaluate, and revise the City's Emergency Operations Plan (EOP). As a subject matter expertise, this role will participate in Fire Department, Homeland Security, and Emergency Management grant management duties.

An equivalent combination of education and experience may be used to meet this requirement. Bachelor's degree preferred but not required for consideration.
