Appointments are made each year by the president of VACo. Steering Committees

Agriculture and Rural Affairs: Agriculture and rural affairs activities affected by laws and regulations.

Community, Economic, and Workforce Development: Community development, economic development, workforce development, infrastructure, and growth management.

Education: PreK-12 public education issues, including funding, school construction, and local authority.

Environment, Energy, and Land

Use: Environment, affordable and reliable electricity, renewable energy sources, energy efficiency, and land use issues.

Finance and Elections: Appropriations, taxation, and elections.

General Government: General Government issues such as Freedom of Information, procurement, public safety, and cybersecurity.

Health and Human Resources: Social services, Children's Services Act, behavioral health, and related issues.

Transportation: Transportation issues.

Operational Committees

Budget and Finance: Establishes a budget format and a budget that directs resources to the top priorities set by the membership to allow the association to achieve its goals. The Committee periodically reviews VACo's investment policy and develops recommendations to the Board regarding policy modifications.

Conference Planning Committee: VACo's conference planning committee helps assure that the annual meeting provides members with valuable information for planning and implementing new ideas and technologies and serves as a focal point for imparting information about legislative issues.

Nominating Committee: This committee meets before the annual business meeting and prepares a slate of officers to present to the attending membership.
