According to the Commission on School Construction and Modernization the majority of public schools in Virginia are 50 years or older and the estimated cost of construction needed to replace and modernize these buildings is \$25 billion.



What the Legislation Does

[HB 600](#), [HB 805](#), & [SB 14](#) would give all Virginia counties and cities another tool to address a priority community issue that directly affects children, parents, and citizens.

Give your locality the authority to raise up to 1% local sales and use tax if approved by local voter referendum. If implemented, the revenues would be solely dedicated to the costs of new school construction and modernization. **This authority is currently successfully exercised by nine localities.**

This legislation could be a solution for numerous communities across the Commonwealth by providing revenue diversification. No local government will be mandated to exercise this authority if they or their citizens do not wish to do so.
