Support <u>HB 600, HB 805, & SB 14</u>

It makes Cents to Fund Virginia's Schools.

According to the Commission on School Construction and Modernization the majority of public schools in Virginia are 50 years or older and the estimated cost of construction needed to replace and modernize these buildings is \$25 billion.



What the Legislation Does

HB 600, HB 805, & SB 14 would give all Virginia counties and cities another tool to address a priority community issue that directly affects children, parents, and citizens.

Give your locality the authority to raise up to 1% local sales and use tax if approved by local voter referendum. If implemented, the revenues would be solely dedicated to the costs of new school construction and modernization. This authority is currently successfully exercised by nine localities.

Mission

No child in Virginia should have to go to a school with a leaky roof, an insufficient HVAC system, or one that was built prior to World War I.

Every child deserves to go to a safe and modern school.
